

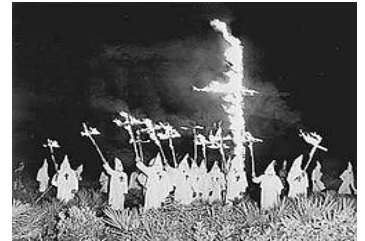

What will I learn on the A-Level course?

Unit 1J: The Making of a Superpower: USA 1865-1975 (40% of A-Level)

This unit provides an overview of US history from the end of the Civil War to Vietnam and the Watergate Scandal. It was a time of great change, when America arrived on the world stage, growing into the global super power that we know today.

You will be assessed on this course in a **2 hour 30 minute examination** in June 2021.



Unit 2E: The English Revolution 1625-1660 (40% of A-Level).

This course will study the origins of the English Civil War in the seventeenth century. This was a key turning point in the relationship between the Monarchy and Parliament, which contributed significantly to the development of the modern British State.

You will be assessed on this course in a **2 hour 30 minute examination** in June 2021.



Unit 3: Historical Investigation (20% of A-Level)

This unit will give you the opportunity to investigate a historical topic of your own choosing that covers a one hundred year time frame. You will research, plan and write an extended essay that evaluates primary source material and considers the nature of historical debate. Will it be the French Revolution? The fall of the Roman Empire? Women's rights? Political change in Germany? The choice is yours.

You will be assessed by **coursework** of approximately 3500 words in length.
