WHAT WILL I STUDY?

You will study a range of units reflecting the nature of the music industry in the 21st Century. Content within these units will include The Music Industry and Associated Professional Practice, Musical Genres & Styles, Critical Listening & Analysis Skills, Solo and Ensemble Performance Technique, Music Theory, Composition and Studio Recording Techniques.

HOW IS THE COURSE STRUCTURED AND ASSESSED?

The two-year course will consist of project work for 3 large scale coursework components & completion of multiple, smaller 'skills development' units. These units will assess practical performance, composition technique, professional practice and theoretical understanding. Two of the large-scale components are internally assessed with the third set and assessed by the external exam board. All units are compulsory.

HOW WILL I STUDY?

Each week of study on the Level 2 pathway will consist of practical performance, composition tuition, theory development and professional practice. Alongside the formal coursework components, pupils will work towards showcase events, recording sessions and collaborative projects.

Component 1: Exploring Musical Products & Styles. This unit is delivered during year 1 of study.

Component 2: Music Skills Development. This unit is delivered during year 1 & 2 of study.

Component 3: Responding To A Commercial Brief. This unit is delivered during year 2 of study.
