WHAT WILL I STUDY?

For those students resitting GCSE English at Key Stage 5, we offer students the opportunity to be entered for the November and June series of examinations in Year 12.

GCSE English Language allows students to explore the richness and diversity of the English language, to develop their ability to use the highest standards of literacy and oracy, and to investigate and analyse how language is used in fiction and non-fiction writing, as well as to experiment by using language effectively in their own creative and transactional writing.

HOW IS THE COURSE STRUCTURED AND ASSESSED?

Assessment for the resit in GCSE English Language takes the form of two external examinations plus a separate endorsement in spoken language for which students must deliver a presentation and answer questions on a topic of their choice.

In preparation for the examinations, students complete regular practice assessments according to an individually tailored schedule and receive directed feedback from their teachers to ensure swift progress.

HOW WILL I STUDY?

Lessons are taught by subject specialists who also provide directions for independent learning beyond the classroom, thereby consolidating and extending students' knowledge and skills.

Students are assisted in developing their analytical and discursive abilities to the standard required at GCSE. They are encouraged to become more confident in articulating their ideas and interpretations and to develop an effective system for proofreading that will be of benefit in adult life.
