Pearson Level 3 BTEC Extended Diploma in Performing Arts Practice - Dance (603/4669/3)

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

The BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma is an intensive and exciting 2-year course, delivered by highly qualified teaching staff who cover different aspects of the Performing Arts Dance programme. The focus of the course is on the study of dance within a vocational context. You will develop the technical, expressive and performance skills necessary to progress onto further vocational or higher education in dance; alongside developing the choreographic, contextual and theoretical knowledge that will enable you to be successful on the course.

HOW IS THE COURSE STRUCTURED AND ASSESSED?

The BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma in Dance consists of 10 units which will be studied over two years. The course consists entirely of internally set units which are delivered and assessed by BOA Staff, with subsequent standardisation completed by the exam board. You will be assessed through both studio and live performance, in addition to being video recorded for much of your performance work. There are no externally assessed elements within the course, however there is a significant proportion of research and theoretical work; this is a vital component in allowing students to develop their academic skills and contextual knowledge to the same high level as their practical work.

HOW WILL I STUDY?

You will study a broad range of dance and movement techniques over the two years which will include a selection of:

Classical Ballet technique, Tap Dance technique, Jazz Dance technique, Street Dance technique, Contemporary Dance technique and Musical Theatre techniques. This work will be complemented by conditioning classes and by theoretical activities and tasks.
