BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma in Art & Design Practice

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

You'll explore fine art, textiles and photography through practical experimentation and creative projects. Your work could include drawing, painting, printmaking, mixed media, sculpture, fabric and surface design, or photographic image-making. You'll investigate the work of artists, designers and photographers, test materials and techniques, and develop ideas from initial research through to finished outcomes. As the course progresses, you'll specialise in your chosen discipline.

HOW IS THE COURSE STRUCTURED AND ASSESSED?

This is a full-time, two-year course. In Year 1, you'll explore a range of art and design skills through practical projects and a creative brief. In Year 2, you'll advance your chosen practice, develop work for your portfolio and respond to a creative industry brief. You'll be assessed through four units covering how you research ideas, solve problems, apply technical skills, work professionally and communicate your intentions. All units are internally set and assessed, with standards verified by Pearson.

HOW WILL I STUDY?

You'll learn through practical workshops, creative briefs and your own projects in our purpose-built art and design facilities. These include fine art studios, spaces for textiles, ceramics and three-dimensional design, a photography darkroom, and computer suites with graphics tablets and software such as Photoshop, Illustrator and Premiere Pro. You'll experiment, review your work and respond to feedback as you build a portfolio reflecting your chosen specialism.
